



5 days **photo-workshop** in Portico di Romagna June 2012 Workshop-Price: 369 euro

Are you an enthusiastic amateur photographer with a 'certain' level of experience already, then you might be interested in our photo work-shop with the American East-Coast narrative photographer David H. Wells (www.davidhwells.com) who has many years of experience in teaching both professionals and amateurs.

The only thing it requires is a basic level of speaking and understanding English (you don't have to have a very advanced linguistic level and the more specific photo-terms you'll learn while doing: David is a patient and experienced teacher). You bring your own photo gear, and preferably also a laptop.

When:

There will be 2 workshop dates to choose between:

- a) **From Thursday 21 to Tuesday 26, June 2012.**
- b) **From Thursday 28, June, to Tuesday 3, July 2012.**

Where and what to photograph:

The workshop will take place in Portico di Romagna, a small medieval village in the green Apennine mountains, in Romagna, near the Tuscany border, 75 km Northeast of Florence, in the centre of the triangle of Florence, Ravenna and Bologna.

The borgo of Portico and surroundings will offer many photo opportunities, both of landscapes, architecture, but also of the local people living and working there. You'll go on excursions to surrounding villages, handicraft-men 'in action', see different types of landscapes and more.

The workshop base is the hotel-restaurant Al Vecchio Convento in Portico di Romagna.

Program:

- Wednesday evening, on arrival, there will be a presentation of the program and to your teacher, David. The workshop-group will be of a max of 7 participants + David H. Wells.
- Every day (5 in total) there will be a new theme for the day.
- You'll be doing both inside and outside photographing.
- In the mornings (normally from around 7 to 9, depending on the object), there will be a photo-'excursion' together with the others and David.
- In the late Afternoon or Evening, another photo-session with David.
- In the hours between, you'll be on your own or in pairs or a smaller group, working in the field or reviewing your own or the others work- and David will be doing private guiding-lessons. Some days there will also be guided theory-classes for all.
- Saturday or Sunday (depending on photo opportunities) will be a day off, to relax, go on an excursion or whatever you should prefer.

The price and what it includes.

The workshop price: **369 euro**

It includes the above described program with transportation to the excursions out of Portico and the teaching.

It does not include whatever you should choose to do on your day off.

It does not include accommodation and meals.

Accommodation:

We recommend a stay on the hotel Al Vecchio Convento*** with half board.

However we also have availability of some apartments in the village.

Activities for an eventual travel-partner:

If you should want to bring a friend or partner, who doesn't want to participate in the workshop, there are plenty possibilities to do other things: hiking, biking, cooking courses, painting, excursions arranged by the hotel to nearby places.
