In Todi, a gorgeous medieval town that sits atop the hills of Umbria, students can enjoy Italian lifestyle through food, people, art and nature.

La Lingua La Vita, a language school in Todi founded in 1988, offers Italian lessons as well as courses in wine and wine tasting with a certified sommelier. The school also has other various cultural activities in the afternoon including: guided tours to local wineries, trips to well-known cities such as Assisi, Orvieto and Spoleto, and many other beautiful 'off the beaten path' locations.



















CULTURAL PROGRAM

Sunday

Monday (3:30pm)

Guided tour around the Historical Center of Todi followed by an aperitif

An opportunity to chat in Italian over a glass of prosecco outside class in a relaxing atmosphere at a local cafè, bar or restaurant.

Tuesday (3:30pm)

Wine Tasting:

A delicious tasting of Umbrian wine accompanied by a selection of bread and cheeses at Cantina Roccafiore, a beautiful winery, resort and spa near Todi (<u>www.roccafiore.it</u>).

Wednesday (3:00pm)

An afternoon field trip to TORGIANO and a visit to the Museo del Vino in Torgiano. A town just 10km south of Perugia that is believed to be founded by the Etruscans, and is situated on a hill overlooking the confluence of the Chiascio and Tiber Rivers (http://www.lungarotti.it/fondazione/en/MOO/index.php)

Thursday – (3:00pm)

An afternoon excursion to Montefalco - a beautiful hamlet, best known for its "città del Sagrantino" (city of Sagantino) because it offers some of the highest quality Sagrantino wines produced in Italy. Visit to a traditional winerey in the gorgeous medieval town of Bevagna not far from Todi.

Friday- (3:00pm)

Wine Tasting and Cooking Lessons – An expert sommelier will teach the students the secrets of wine tasting and later in the day an Italian family will host a cooking course while preparing a traditional Italian dinner together.

Saturday SPECIAL EVENT (Depending on the season)

Autumn: Pick grapes at an Umbrian vineyard.

Winter: Winter events connected to wine.

Spring: "Cantine Aperte: open days for wineries

Summer: Festivals and other events
