- •(15:00) Spoleto. One of the very first things to see is the Albornoz Fortress which overlooks a large part of the valley of Spoleto. Pope Innocent VI ordered the building of the fortress to restore the authority of the Church over the area. From 1817 to 1982 it was used as a prison and, following extensive restorations that brought to light numerous painted decorations dating from the fourteenth to the eighteenth centuries, has it been the seat of the National Museum of the Duchy of Spoleto since 2007.




